Attention:

- Preferences will be used to guide the Jury but will not limit its decisions.
- The French Laureate must be available to participate to the workshops offered within the "Singapour Fintech Festival" in October 2021.
- The candidates don't need to register for the partner's "network/ecosystem" programmes in parallel. If the chosen laureate selected "Le Swave" program, he/she will have to register on the platform of Paris&Co to integrate its promotion.

Nota Bene: a place in the final for the French prize automatically opens the right to one-year memberships at Finance for Tomorrow and with the ecosystem partners, as well as visibility opportunities. Mentorships will be proposed to "Special Mentions" by the Jury members.

<u>International Prize:</u> the candidates must indicate in the form that they are interested in the "Sustainable Fintech Digital Bootcamp" by ticking the dedicated box.

 - **Creation of economic value** through the response to a concrete problem.
 - **Need for support** to a project under development.
 - o Potential for project development on a national and international scale.
