Creation of the TNFD Consultation Group of France

The associations Entreprises pour l'Environnement (EpE) and Finance For Tomorrow (F4T), branch of Paris EUROPLACE, are announcing the launch of the TNFD Consultation Group of France which will contribute to the development of a relevant and useful framework for economic actors in order to address the issues and risks related to nature.

The Taskforce on Nature-related Financial Disclosure (TNFD) is currently developing a management and reporting framework on nature-related risks and opportunities, in an iterative process and in co-construction with economic players. As for climate, nature-related risks and biodiversity issues are now increasingly taken into account within the dialogue between corporates and financial actors. However, their complete integration remains difficult due to the large number of parameters describing the impacts and dependencies of economic actors on nature.

At the initiative of the French members of the TNFD Taskforce, the DEFi symposium, a dialogue between business and finance on solutions and actions for nature, was organised on June 27th 2022, by EpE and F4T to open the debate between French actors around the management and disclosure framework for nature-related risks and opportunities that the TNFD is preparing.

In order to sustain these dynamics, EpE and F4T have since formed a **French TNFD Consultation Group** open to all French members of the TNFD Forum and to the members of the two associations. This group will allow the pursuit of this dialogue, the participation of French actors to the development of the framework, and faster dissemination and adoption.

A few weeks before the COP 15 on biodiversity, aiming at ratifying the new post 2020 Global biodiversity Framework, the establishment of this group confirms the strong mobilisation of French stakeholders and their ambition to develop solutions for both the preservation and restoration of biodiversity and its better integration in economic decisions.
