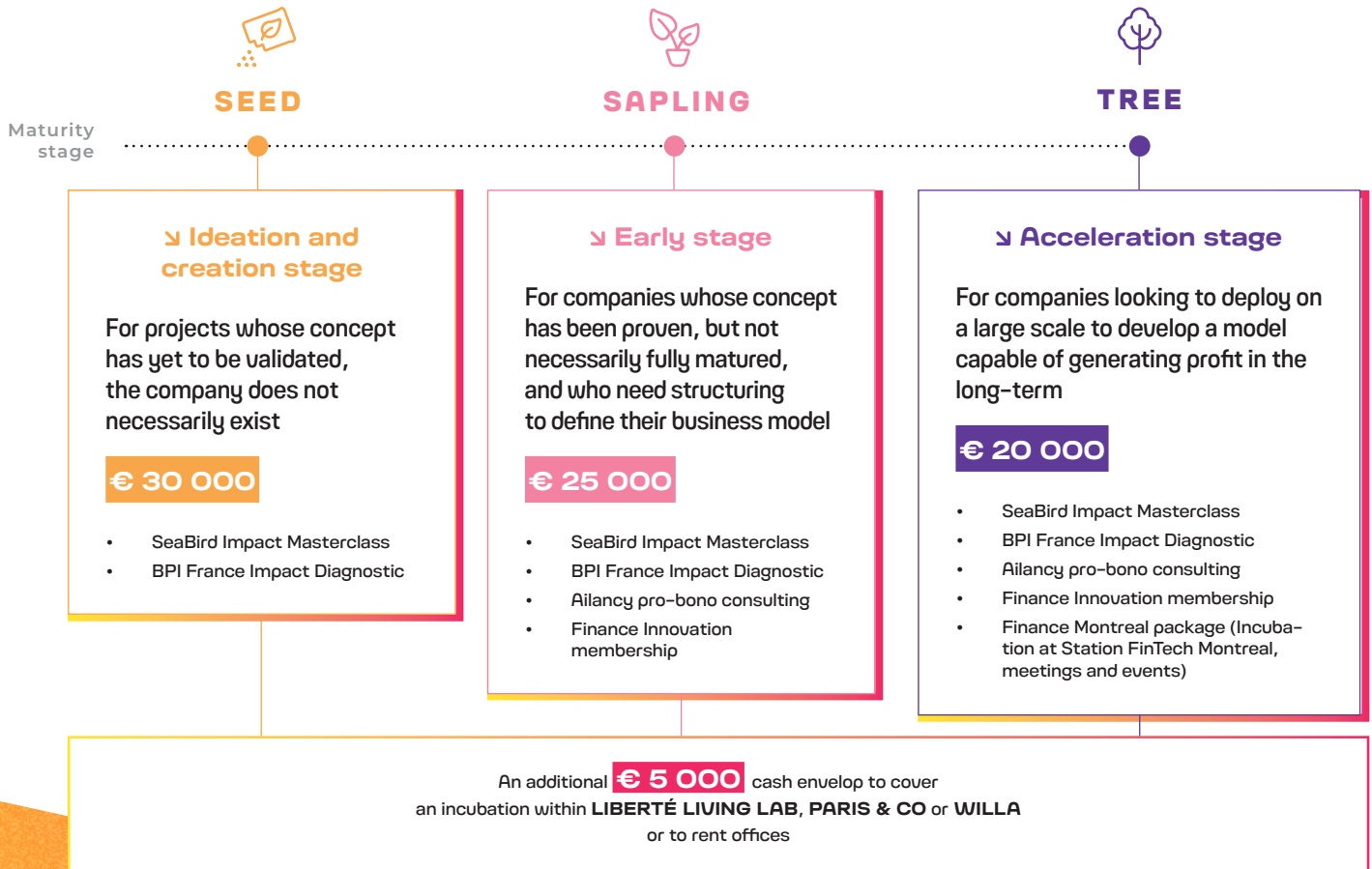

- **A significant contribution to the financial industry in terms of the nature of the solution** (financial or non-financial)
- **A contribution to the ecological transition present in most of its activity** on one of the following pillars:
 - Environmental
 - Social
 - Gouvernance
- **An innovative nature** through the technology employed or the usage, with the change introduced by the use of the product or consumption of the service.

A special attention to Diversity and Inclusion

Despite the issues tackled by Sustainable Fintechs, diversity, inclusion and mixity remain major challenges for tomorrow's entrepreneurs. With a high degree of social uniformity within entrepreneurial profiles, **the innovation ecosystem must enable the overcoming of the many remaining obstacles linked to territorial social inequalities and discrimination based on origin or a related ground.**

For the sixth edition of the Fintech for Tomorrow Challenge, jury members will be asked to **systematically** pay a particular attention to the entrepreneurs' profiles, with the aim of awarding at least one of the three prizes (seed, sapling or tree) to under-represented or atypical profiles.
